COURAGE TO MAKE 'SURVIVABLE' MISTAKES

Give everyone in your crew the chance to make survivable mistakes in order to grow. That creates a team culture of trust. Because errors are human. A chain of errors is deadly.

FLYING YOU ONLY LEARN BY FLYING

Pilots switch roles after each flight. Those who claim accountability must give their crews the opportunity to do so. Every captain needs people on bord telling him what he needs to know. Not what he wants to hear.

Teams often fail due to 'Captain's Syndrome', which results from steep hierarchies and rigid routines. Leaders should constantly change perspectives and act as 'Pilot Monitoring'.


THE CREW MAKES THE DIFFERENCE

PILOT

In 2003, at the age of 22, Philip Keil is among the youngest airline pilots in Germany. He completed more than 9,000 flying hours on four continents.

In 2009 a routine flight in Africa with almost 200 people on bord turns into an immediate emergency. Philip Keil can control the situation and manages to land the airplane safely. Only days later, he is back in the cockpit.



KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Since 2014 Philip Keil treads the boards as keynote speaker all over Europe. **Since 2017** he has ranked among the international 'TOP100 Excellent Keynote Speakers'. In over 20 countries in Europe and Asia, he has reached tens of thousands of people with his keynotes.
